EVENT CANCELLATIONS AT THE BUTLER ARTS & EVENTS CENTER

Indianapolis – UPDATED MARCH 17 – In accordance with the most recent directives from Governor Holcomb and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention concerning COVID 19, events at the Butler Arts and Events Center are cancelled the next eight (8) weeks through Monday, May 11, 2020. Additional events outside of that date range may also cancel so patrons are encouraged to check ButlerArtsCenter.org for the most up-to-date show information regarding cancellations and rescheduled/postponed events.

Indianapolis - On March 12 Governor Eric J. Holcomb announced additional steps the state will take to reduce the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) in Indiana. “Non-essential gatherings must be limited to no more than 250 people. This includes any event or gathering of people who are in one room or a single space at the same time, such as cafeterias, churches, stadiums, meeting and conference rooms, auditoriums and the like.” Additionally, Mayor Joe Hogsett and the Marion County Health Department announced local restrictions related to all non-essential gatherings effective for the next thirty (30) days.

With this, events at the **Butler Arts & Events Center (of Butler University)** are cancelled today through **Sunday, April 12** and updates will be provided on an event-by-event basis as additional cancellations may take place. The Butler Arts & Events Center will work with its presenting partners on rescheduling upcoming performances and will provide more details to its patrons regarding each show as soon as possible. In the meantime, patrons should not visit the Butler Arts & Events Center venues including Clowes Memorial Hall, Schrott Center for the Arts, Shelton Auditorium, Lilly Hall Studio Theatre or Eidson-Duckwall Recital Hall until further notice.

We will be in contact with those via email with tickets to a performance. We ask patrons to please be patient as there are many performances to be addressed.

The Butler Arts & Events Center will continue to post updates on ButlerArtsCenter.org as well as through email and social media platforms.

We appreciate the leadership from our University and public officials and will continue to comply with guidance and directives to ensure the health and well-being of our students, faculty, staff and patrons.
